1. LINK LESSON :

(A) To derive indeclinables from pronouns + secondary suffixes. Likewise several indeclinable words exist underivable.

2. DERIVATION of WORDS (ŚABDA) with Primary suffixes :

In Sanskrit, Important Verbs= Dhātus are 500, collected in Dhātupāṭha composed by Pāṇini in 500 B.C. Dhātu means metal. You can produce thousand of instruments from one metal. Likewise you can derive thousand of words from a Dhātu of Sanskrit. Verb+Primary Suffixes. Such as in English : State+ion=station; educate+ion=education. In Sanskrit √गम् + अन = गमनम् going etc.

(A) Students derive thousand of words in Sanskrit from root+suffixes and decide their genders and meanings.

(B) These words are called Śabda or stem as gold found from the mines, raw material, not to use as an ornament to put around the neck.

3. TADDHITAS : WORD + SUFFIXES :

(A) As in English word education+al suffixe=educational, education+ist=educationist etc.

4. ŚABDAS ARE CONVERTED into PADA :

(A) In Sanskrit post-positions are used in the place of prepositions (of English) to make PADA from a Śabda. These Post positions are called case-endings: Kārakas. These Padas can be used in a sentence as an ornament but not Śabda.

5. TENSES : PRESENT, PAST FUTURE & MOODS :

(A) Ten conjugations (Avatāras), Sārvadhātuka and Ārdha-Dhātuka Kāla, Parasmaipadam & Ātmanepadam.
